

DRESS CODE

Members and guests should dress in a manner which maintains the dignity of the game of golf. Members and their guests are asked to observe the following minimum acceptable standards.

As a general rule, neat and tidy golf attire and neat, smart casual wear is acceptable within the Club.

Members and guests who do not comply with the Dress Code will be refused service and asked to leave the premises. If you are unsure, please contact the Club for guidance prior to arrival.

When visiting the Club for a short period of time (10 minutes) it is not necessary for Members to strictly adhere to the Dress Code This dispensation does not extend to the Lounge, Terrace Room or Dining Room, or to the course or practice facilities.

The Dress Code disallows thongs, board shorts, surf shirts, and singlets.

Neat and clean denim (not stressed and with no holes) is permitted in the Clubhouse and surrounds but not on the course.

Smart casual shoes are permitted in the Clubhouse and surrounds.

On the course and practice facilities, in the Clubhouse surrounds and, in the Lounge, Terrace Room or Dining Room:

- Golf attire should be neat, tidy, and appropriate for the conditions
- Golf shirts must be tucked in (applies to men only) and have fold down collars or mock turtleneck
- Cargo shorts (with multiple side pockets) are not permitted
- Golf shoes with soft spikes
- Exercise clothing (eg leggings) should not be worn on the course unless under appropriate golfing attire

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
